Supplementary Regulations for an Open Two Day Trial to be held on **September 28**th / **29th 2019** starting at 11.00am Saturday, & 9.30am on Sunday from the **Flask Inn** on the Whitby/Scarborough Road A171.

- JURISDICTION The trial will be held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations of the A.C.U. together with these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions. Permit Number ACU 57083
- 2 COMPETITORS ELIGIBLE Open to all members of a club affiliated to the A.C.U. THIS TRIAL IS INTENDED FOR CENTRE LEVEL RIDERS AND BELOW AND SECTIONS WILL BE DESIGNED FOR THEM.
- 3 MACHINES. Solo motorcycles only. These must comply with the road traffic act and the A.C.U. Standing Regulations in all respects.

 All m/c's will be examined by the m/c examiner before being allowed to start.
- 4 COURSE Varied terrain including some public roads.

 The course will be different each day and both will be of a single lap.
- 5 OBSERVED SECTIONS Will be clearly marked and numbered.

Method of marking will be in accordance with TSR 22-A

The Course and Observed Sections will be closed by a Back Marker.

- 6 TIES To be resolved in accordance with Trial Standing Regulations.
- 7 AWARDS

To qualify for a Club Award a rider must have been a member of that Club on August 1st of the current

and the **Entry Fee of £42.00** to reach the Secretary of the meeting not later than **Tues. 17th Sept.**The entry fee includes insurance for third party off road risks, the ACU subscription, a snack lunch

during the Sunday run, plus a meal at the presentation following the Trial. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without reason.

An entry limit of 150, on a first entered basis, will be imposed. ENTRIES CANNOT BE TRANSFERRED BY AN ENTRANT.

- 9 NUMBERS To be issued on the basis, early entry late number. any rider preferring an early number may indicate this on the entry form.
- 10 SIGNING ON At signing on each rider will receive his Punch Card for which he is responsible. If you loose your punch card you will be classed as retired.
- 11 STARTING After successful machine examination riders will be despatched at 30 second intervals. If a rider fails to start at his appointed time he will incur a 1 mark penalty for each minute he is late, up to a maximum of 20 marks, after which he will be disqualified. A rider who does not complete the Saturday course may ride on Sunday on a no award basis.

 Starting order will be the same on both days.
- 12 SUBSTITUTION OF MACHINE In accordance with Trial Standing Regulations. NO change of machine is permitted after starting.
- 13 PRACTISING in the vicinity of the course before or after the event entails disqualification.
- 14 OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOUR At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course any rider who is reported to him for offensive behaviour will be excluded.
- 15 PETROL Riders petrol will be taken each day to a petrol halt if in a can clearly marked "PETROL".
- 16 INTERPRETATION of these regulations and the infliction of penalties for breach of same rests entirely with the officials of the meeting. Protests must be in accordance with A.C.U. National Sporting Code. OFFICIALS
